That's just ONE of things I'm talking about today. LOTS to discuss here and some NEW discoveries that are super cool and time saving AND moneymaking of course.

Before I get to the You Talk ChatGPT types, did you know that CANVA has now added AI image creation?

That is pretty darned cool.

You tell it what image you want and it creates it.

Canva also added AI Writing in their doc feature. I assume that is via an API to ChatGPT. Very cool.

I won't deep dive into these now. Maybe another issue.

I love Canva. Their background removal feature is incredible.

Let me show you a picture:

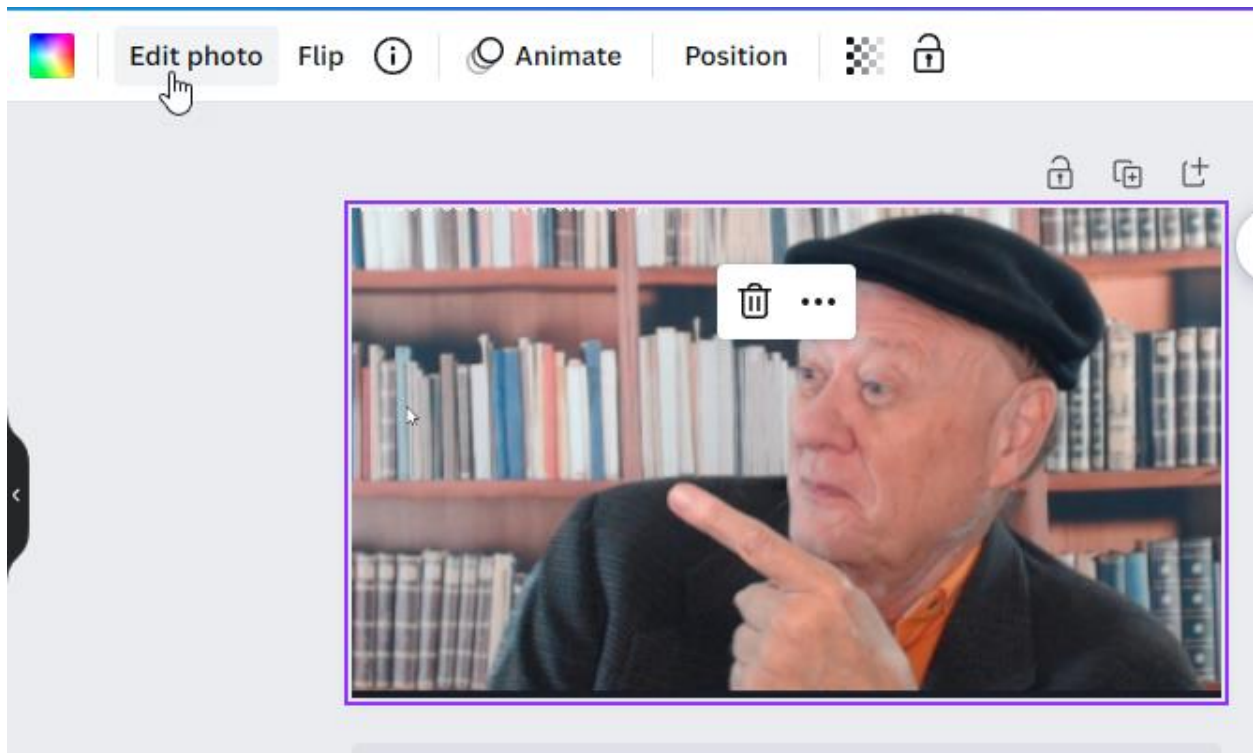


I just used Snagit to grab a screen shot of this off of my OBS Software (It's free software that I use for live streams).

But as you can see, we have all the books in the background. Those are really a backdrop. BEHIND the backdrop is a whole wall of real books that are NOT nearly so neat! lol.

Anyway, I need to remove the books so I can add text.

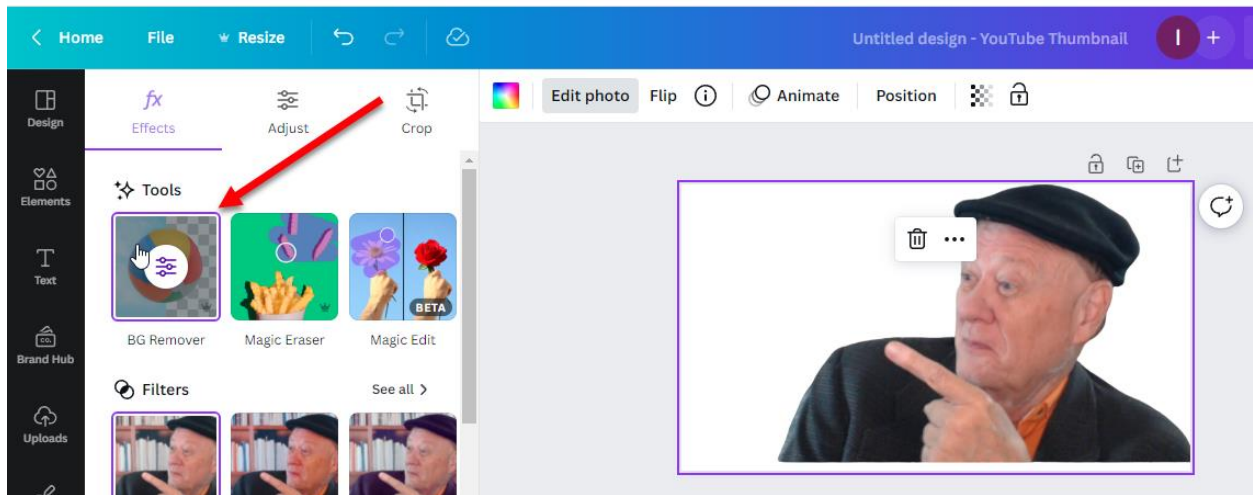
I drop it into Canva and hit EDIT PHOTO:



“remove background.”

BOOM!

In one click there’s no background.



Then I just add a color to the background and text.

Usually, though I just start with one of their templates and edit it. So simple.

### **How One Click A.I. Is Helping Me Creating HOT Youtube Descriptions That Will Get My Videos More Clicks**

So I have a bunch of Youtube videos and lives.

That PROBLEM IS, I didn't add a good description about each video. And I NEED a description that has the keywords in it I want to be found by.

Manually writing each description is a LABORIOUS process.

That's why I'm SO FREAKING DELIGHTED my friend Joe turned me onto the 1 click A.I. tools that is FREE! And it happens to create instant descriptions for me.

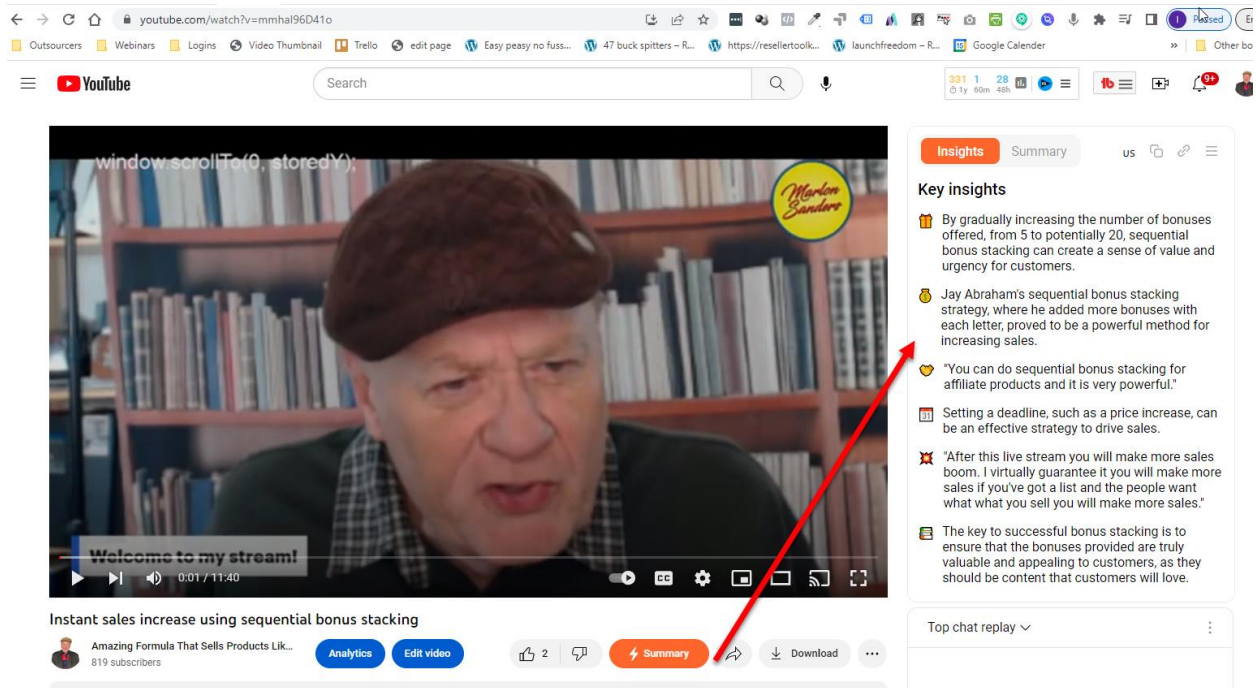
To me this is truly JAW DROPPING TECHNOLOGY.

I mean that.

Before I found out about this a month ago, I would have had to hire a person on Fiverr and pay \$10 or \$20 or more for each video to get notes.

But NOW watch this:

I just click the SUMMARY BUTTON:



And it spits out the KEY INSIGHTS on the right of the video. I just copy some, part or all of it and drop it into the description of the video.

BOOM!

Instant description.

So cool.

The tool is a Chrome Extension called Eightify in the Chrome store. My friend Joe Lavery discovered this.

He's truly a genius at coming up with all these undiscovered tools like this. I WISH he'd writing and sell a Ninja Tools newsletter. I bet people would pay \$10 or \$20 a month for it, if not more, because he discovers the coolest stuff!

### **Joe Lavery's You Talk, It Types ChatGPT Method**

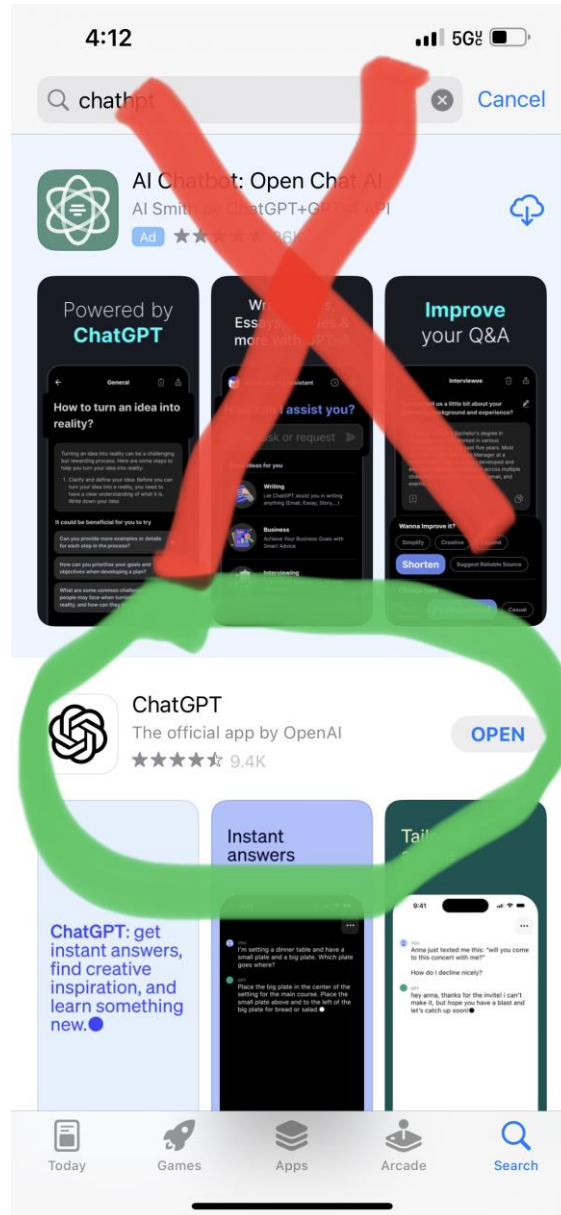
While Joe didn't invent this, he's the first person who showed it to me. And the first person I found that explained it simply where you can actually do it.

So cool.

Now, on your PHONE, when you're in ChatGPT on a mobile browser, you just click the microphone and you can type with your voice.

I HAD NO IDEA YOU COULD DO THIS.

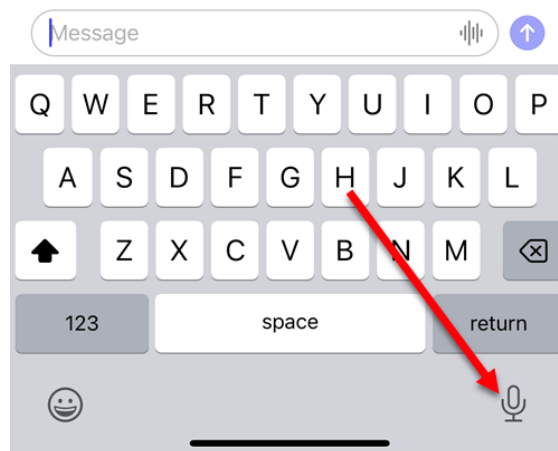
Instead of going to the ChatGPT website, I prefer the FREE ChatGPT app. But sure to download the official FREE app, and not a variation app that you have to pay for:



Install it, then open it.

Just click the microphone icon in order to enable voice typing RIGHT INTO ChatGPT:

11:52



Relax.

They have this app for both Android and IOS! So everyone gets to use it.

So you can AMAZE YOUR FRIENDS by pulling up the ChatGPT App and type right into it by speaking.

You can do the SAME THING on Desktop but you need a Chrome Extension to do it.



Joes loves the extension called VOICEIN. You need the paid version called PLUS. It's currently \$8 a month or \$3 a month if you pay for the year. Or something like a hundred bucks for LIFETIME.

But there are also FREE APPS that do the same thing.

Here's one called VoiceWave: ChatGPT Voice Control

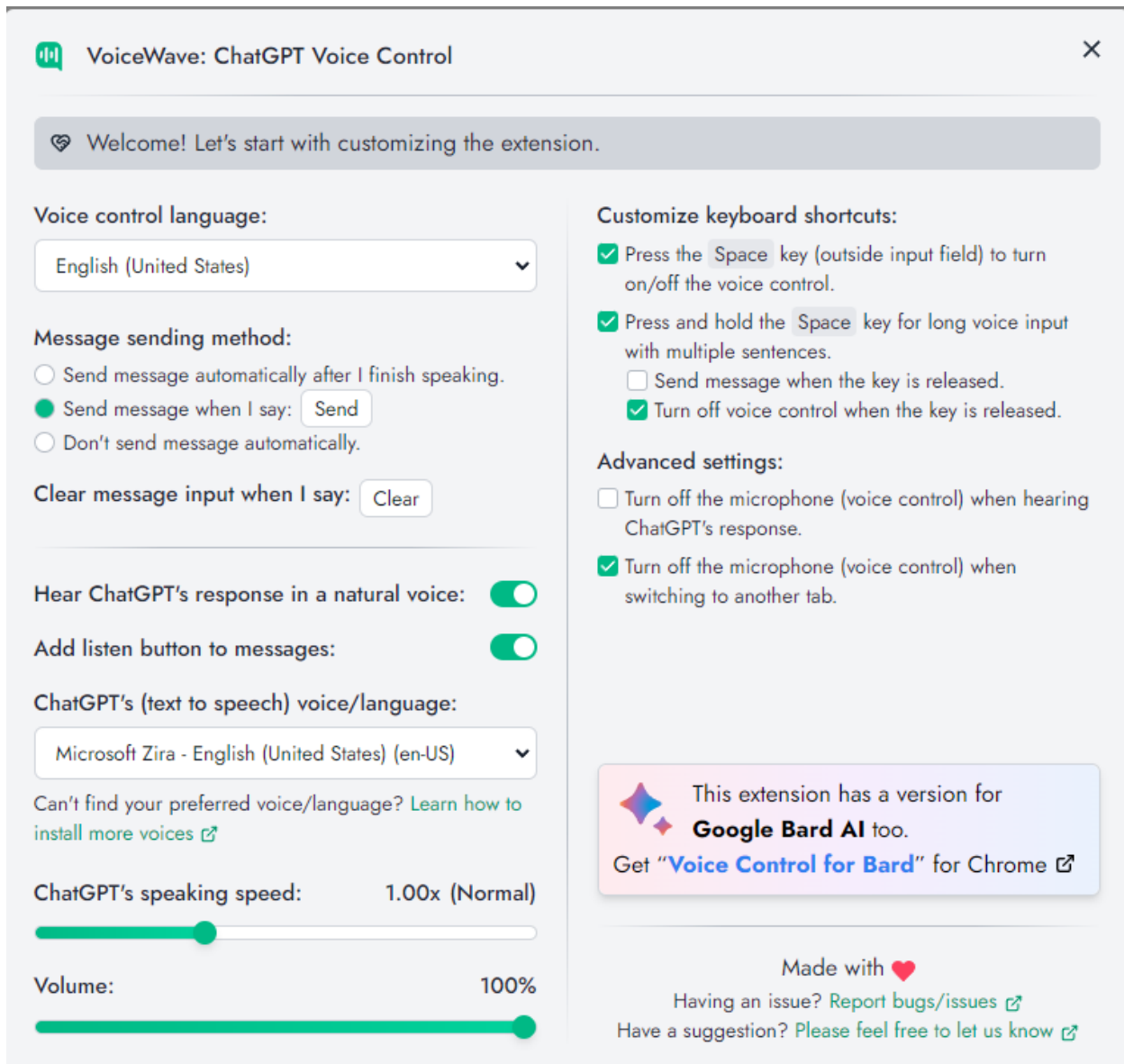

It's free.

Once you have it set up, you just hit the space bar to enable talking into ChatGPT. Pretty slick.

It has a number of options you can set. It works out of the box and is very easy. But if you want to make tweaks, you can do that:

For those of you hard core AI people, you can also install a voice to text command for Google Bard.



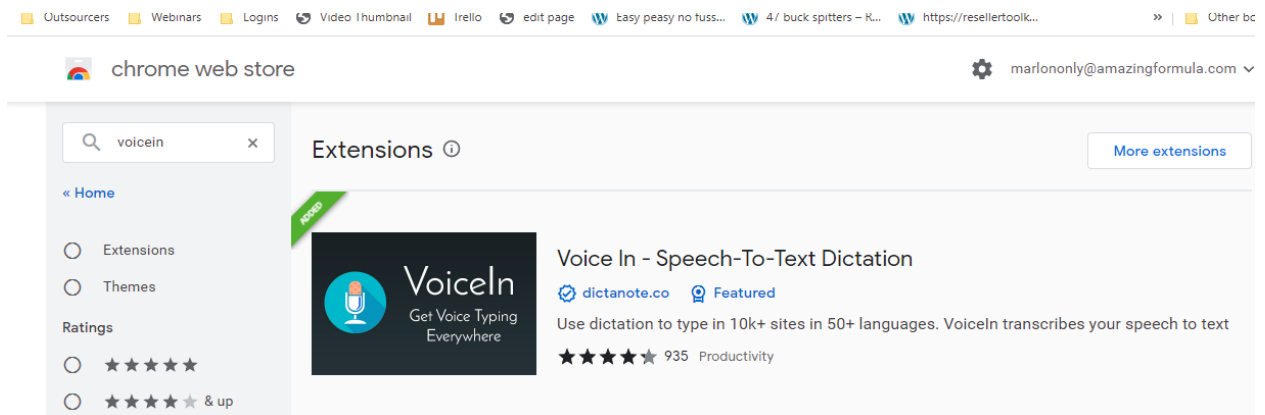
If you have Joe's Way: Secrets of a ChatGPT Magician, Joes goes into a FREE one on his video as well as VOICEIN.

I'm just going to cover VOICEIN here briefly.

It's easy.

You go to your [Chrome extensions web store](#):

Search for VoiceIn:

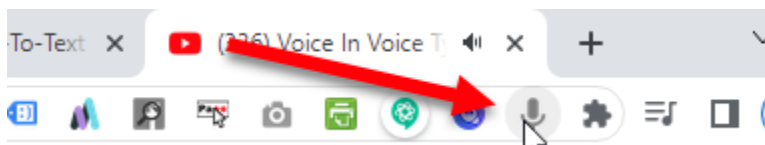

All you do is click the little microphone on your top bar and start talking:



You can actually create VOICE COMMANDS in VoiceIn so that you just give a command and it will AUTOMATICALLY bring up ChatGPT.

How cool is that?

You can create all kinds of custom commands for your computer. This is SUPER COOL! I know you can do that with Dragon Naturally Speaking. But I don't know if it's this EASY.

This is SO EASY!!

But there are many other ways to give voice commands to ChatGPT. I asked ChatGPT to explain these for you:

1. Virtual Assistant Integration: You can integrate a virtual assistant like Siri, Google Assistant, or Cortana with your desktop system. By issuing voice commands to these assistants, you can ask them to interact with ChatGPT on your behalf. For example, you can say, "Hey Siri, ask ChatGPT what the weather is like today."
2. Text-to-Speech (TTS) Software: You can use a text-to-speech software or application that allows you to convert your typed commands into spoken words. Simply type your message or command for ChatGPT, and the software will read it aloud. The speech recognition capability of your desktop system can then capture your response and convert it back into text for ChatGPT to process.
3. Voice Recognition Software: There are voice recognition software options available that can transcribe your spoken commands into text. You can use this software in conjunction with a chat interface or a text-based AI model like ChatGPT. Simply speak your command, and the software will convert it to text input that can be sent to the AI model.
4. Smart Speaker Integration: If you have a smart speaker like Amazon Echo or Google Home connected to your desktop system, you can leverage its voice capabilities to communicate with ChatGPT. The smart speaker can act as an intermediary, relaying your spoken commands to ChatGPT and providing the responses audibly.
5. Dedicated Voice Command Applications: There are applications specifically designed to enable voice command functionalities on desktop systems. These applications typically allow you to define custom voice commands and associated actions. By configuring such an application, you can set up voice commands to trigger actions like sending queries to ChatGPT and receiving the AI model's responses.

Remember, while these methods can facilitate voice-based interaction with AI models like ChatGPT, they may require additional software or integration to make the process seamless. It's essential to explore available options, considering your specific desktop setup and the compatibility of voice-enabled technologies with the chat interface you plan to use.

### **Here's The Big Picture**

Once you set this up, all you do is talk and what you say is typed into ChatGPT. You submit it. And then ChatGPT does its thing.

I haven't tried it yet. But I imagine you can set up a voice command to submit when you use VOICEIN.
